5. NEW AND UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- 5.1 Matters arising from Okanagan Basin Water Board Meeting of August 29, 2006
 - 5.1.1 Greater Vernon Water Conservation Committee

Appointment of Tricia Brett to replace Mary Bowcock

Chair Siddon introduced new representative Tricia Brett representing the Greater Vernon Water Conservation Committee. Mary Bowcock had resigned.

5.1.2 Website Funding Approval and Progress

5.1.2.1 The OBWB approved \$16,000 to establish an Okanagan Community of Interest on the waterbucket.ca website

Staff met with representatives of the Waterbucket Website along with the NORD Computer Systems Manager on July 12, 2006. The website would cost \$16,000 covering the initial design, template development and site customization. Environment Canada and NRCan would be contributing an additional \$10,000 to adapt the Okanagan Waterscape poster and integrate it with the website. Mr. Armour confirmed that Waterbucket staff have indicated that there would be no annual administrative fee as this cost would be covered by sponsors of the website.

Website content would be supplied from a variety of sources. There is information on Okanagan water issues that can be relocated from other parts of the Waterbucket website. Individual Water Stewardship members are strongly encouraged to submit reports and news items, which will be edited and posted by OBWB Staff.

5.1.2.2 Ingenius Web Designs of Vernon has been retained to develop a stand-alone OBWB website which will link to the waterbucket.ca site

The stand-alone OBWB website would be distinct from the NORD site. The website would be set up for a cost of \$2500 and be maintained by Staff. Staff is currently developing content for the site.

5.1.3 Proposed Sale of Leased Lots

5.1.3.1 The OWSC letter opposing the sale of reservoir lots was received by the Water Board and will be included as expert support for correspondence

with Minister Bell and copied to all Provincial Ministers

5.1.4 Facilitated Workshop Update

Chair Siddon informed the Water Stewardship Council that recent subcommittee meetings had been productive and that scheduling a facilitated meeting on September 22, 2006 would be unnecessary.

6. REPORTS FROM COMMITTEE GROUPS

6.1 Terms of Reference

6.1.1 The OBWB gave conditional approval of the Terms of Reference for the Okanagan Water Stewardship Council at its meeting held August 29, 2006, subject to OWSC review

6.1.1.1 Terms of Reference, Community Charter, OBWB Objectives and Purpose

Comments from the Water Stewardship Council included simplifying the Mission Statement and the Vision Statement.

Dr. Sears noted that the Principles would be incorporated into the Terms of Reference pending development of a final draft.

Ms. Hartley exited the meeting at 2:12 p.m.

Attention was drawn to the communication protocol in the Terms of Reference, as follows:

- a. the Council would provide recommendations directly to the OBWB;
- b. the Chair or Vice Chair of the Council and Council staff would speak on the Council's behalf:
- c. the OBWB would retain the option to designate another member of the Council to act as spokesperson on a particular issue;
- d. individual Council members would not communicate with the public or media on behalf of the Council, except as stated, above; and

e. individuals may speak for themselves or their organization on all issues, providing it is clear that they are not speaking for the Council.

Mr. Maddock exited the meeting at 2:30 p.m.

Conflict of Interest issues would be subject to regulations of the British Columbia Community Charter.

Dr. Sears requested that Members email any comments to her.

The Okanagan Water Stewardship Council broke for recess at 3:05 p.m. and reconvened at 3:22 p.m.

The Council agreed that Item 6.1.3 would be addressed before Item 6.1.2.

6.1.3 Draft Okanagan Water Stewardship Council Work Plan

Dr. Sears gave a report on the Draft Work Plan for October 2006 – 2007. Discussion ensued regarding length and frequency of meetings along with the priority of the potential discussion topics.

She added that though the Council included some of the most active and involved individuals in the Basin, each Member may be unfamiliar with one or more issue areas. By systematically discussing the breadth of Okanagan water issues, the Council would be prepared to produce informed and nuanced technical and policy recommendations for action by the OBWB and community.

Potential priority discussion topics outlined in the report were:

- 1. Overview of Water Governance
- 2. First Nations
- 3. Source Protection
- 4. Drought Management Planning
- 5. Water Quality
- 6. Agricultural Irrigation
- 7. Water Economics
- 8. Environment, Fisheries and Wildlife
- 9. Water and Land Use Planning
- 10. Water Conservation Program, Education, and Outreach
- 11. Communication Strategy

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The OBWB at their August 29, 2006 meeting approved the Water Stewardship Council spending up to \$10,000 for experts to attend Council meetings and \$15,000 for Consultants to work on a Sustainable Water Strategy.
