6. REPORTS FROM STAFF and/or COMMITTEE GROUPS

6.1 Matters arising from May 1, 2007 OBWB Meeting

Chair Siddon reported that Dr. Sears is replacing the retiring Mr. Greg Armour as the lead staff of the Okanagan Basin Water Board. She will take on the new title of Executive Director. Dr. Sears indicated that a new Water Stewardship Director may be hired as early as August 2007, and that the job posting will be circulated to all directors in early June.

Valerie Cameron has accepted a position as the new Regional Water Manager for the Ministry of Environment Water Stewardship division in Kamloops. Ken Cunningham will be her replacement on the Water Stewardship Council.

6.1.1 2007 Water Management Grant Awards

Ms. Doyle reported on the second year of the Water Conservation and Quality Improvement Grant Awards. Seventeen grants totaling \$300,000 have been awarded to municipalities and community groups throughout the Okanagan Valley to conduct water conservation and quality improvement projects. 6.2 Effluent studies

6.2.1 Monitoring project

Dr. Sears explained that pharmaceutical and personal care product residues in wastewater are of great concern and that Okanagan Nation Alliance (ONA) is considering an application to the First Nation Environmental Toxicity Fund to further explore this issue in partnership with the Water Stewardship Council. It was confirmed that a sub-committee chaired by Mike Adams with members Bernie Bauer, Denise Neilsen, Jeff Curtis and Fabian Alexis will report back at the next OWSC meeting. Genevieve Doyle will represent the Okanagan Basin Water Board on this committee.

6.2.2 PARC proposal

Dr. Pascal Delaquis presented a proposal on the use of wastewater from the District of Summerland wastewater treatment plant as a source of irrigation water in orchards and to monitor the effects on fruit, soil and irrigation water quality. Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada's Matching Investment Initiative program will provide a matching contribution of cash and in-kind contributions received from industry. A cash contribution from the Okanagan Basin Water Board of \$10,000 per year for the duration of the project's three year term is sought.

6.4 CWRA conference proposal for February, 2008

The Canadian Water Resources Association (CWRA) approached the OBWB to explore the possibility of co-hosting a Water Stewardship conference in February 2008.

Brian Guy pointed out that the timing of this conference is well-suited to public promotion of both the Okanagan Water Stewardship Council and the Water Supply and Demand Study (WS&D): two years into the OWSC's three-year mandate, and the half-way point for the WS&D Study. The CWRA has considerable conference planning expertise and will offset conference costs through admissions fees and sponsorships.
