The City of Armstrong provides water to its residents and 6 other water works districts and is currently undertaking improvements to its water conservation program and upgrading treatment facilities. As a part of these initiatives the City is also incorporating leak detection, universal metering and public education. The project funded by the OBWB is for leak detection within the city and at connections to the 6 water works districts. The City of Armstrong is keen to reduce water consumption and treatment costs for the residents and feels that leak detection is a vital component to the overall program.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, the City of Armstrong has asked for a deferral of the grant amount until the budget can be expanded for this project and will be revisited in the 2008 fiscal year. This project will re-commence in Spring of 2008.
