Agents catch Zebra mussels at Osoyoos border



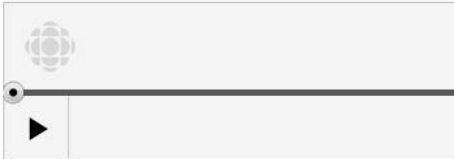
