



Water Board opens call for grant submissions

The Okanagan Basin Water Board is looking for suggestions on how to improve water quality and quantity.

A total of \$300,000 is up for grabs as the OBWB opens it's call for submissions for it's 2011 Water Conservation and Quality Improvement Grant program.

Executive Director, Anna Warwick Sears says applicants should think big.

"We really favour grants that have a broader application. Either they add up to bigger basin wide plan, for instance, the foreshore inventory mapping. We're trying to encourage that all the foreshore gets mapped in terms of what development is happening and what the sensitive areas are."

Successful applicants could receive up to \$30,000 for their project.

Applications will be accepted until February 21, 2011.
