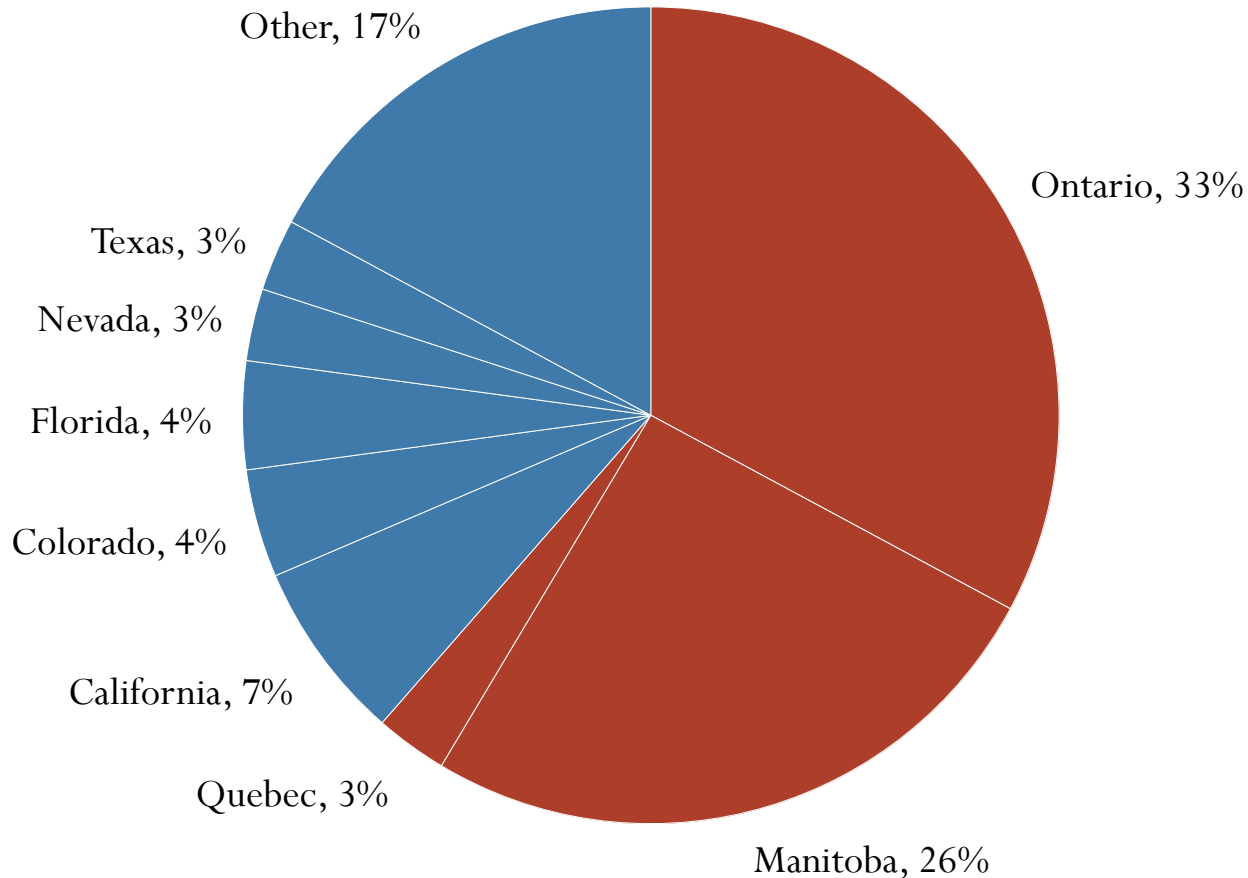


# BC's 2015 Invasive Mussel Pilot

- A total of 4,350 watercraft were inspected by 6 inspection crews who interacted with over 10,000 people to promote CLEAN, DRAIN, DRY.
- 70 watercraft were identified as coming from a zebra/quagga mussel infested province or state, 15 were confirmed to have invasive mussels or larvae and 6 were issued a 30-day quarantine order.

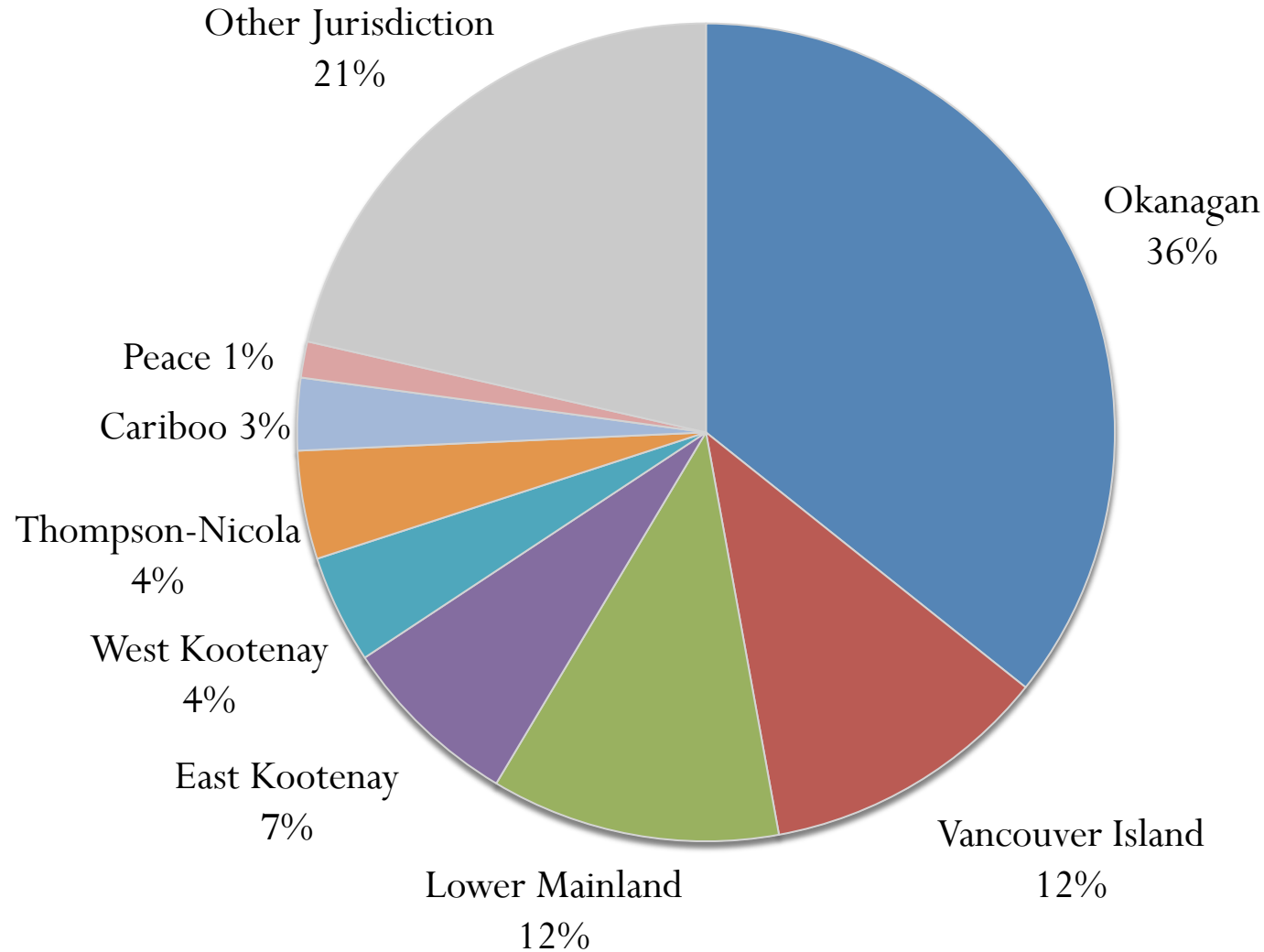


# 2015 Data: Source of High Risk Watercraft



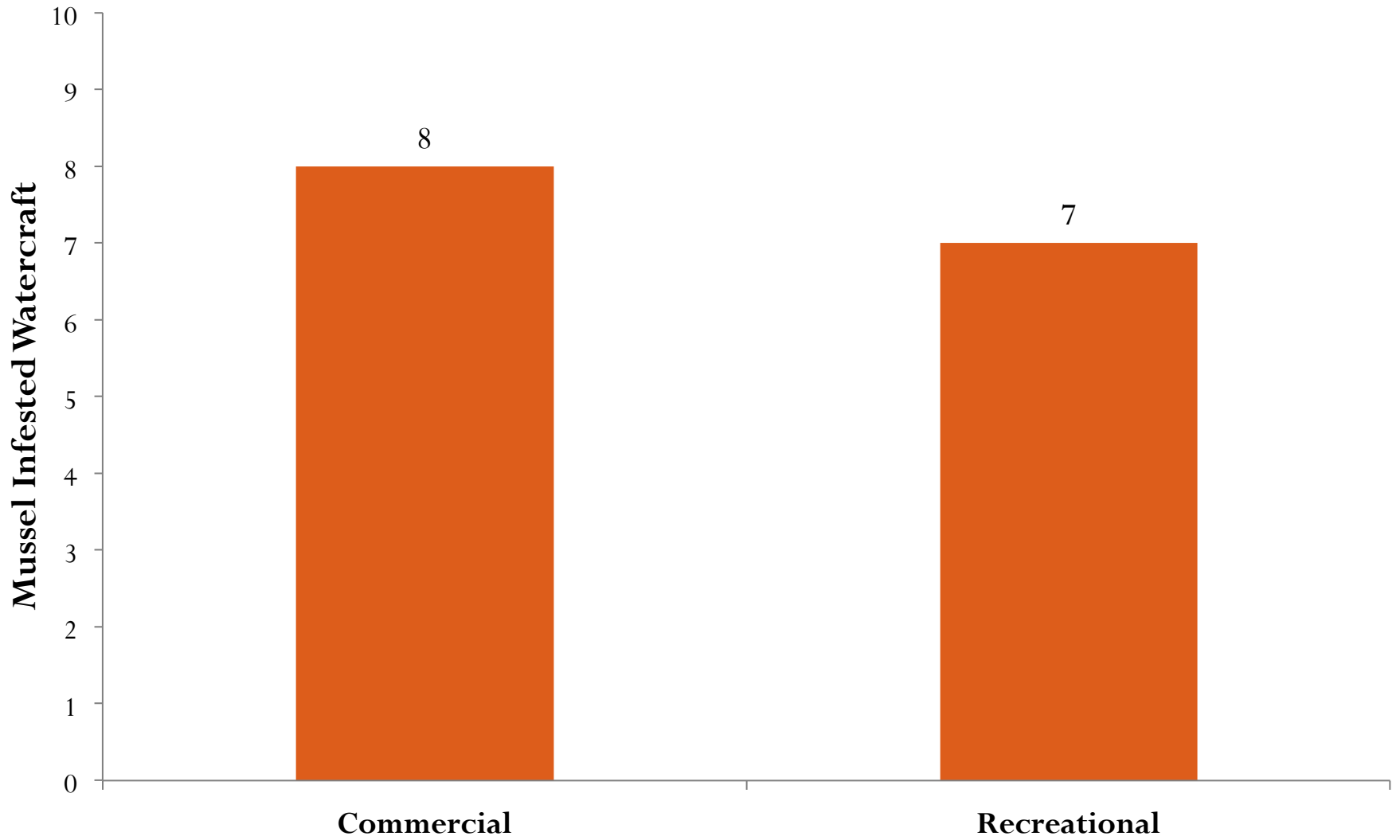

# 2015 Data: Destination of High Risk Watercraft

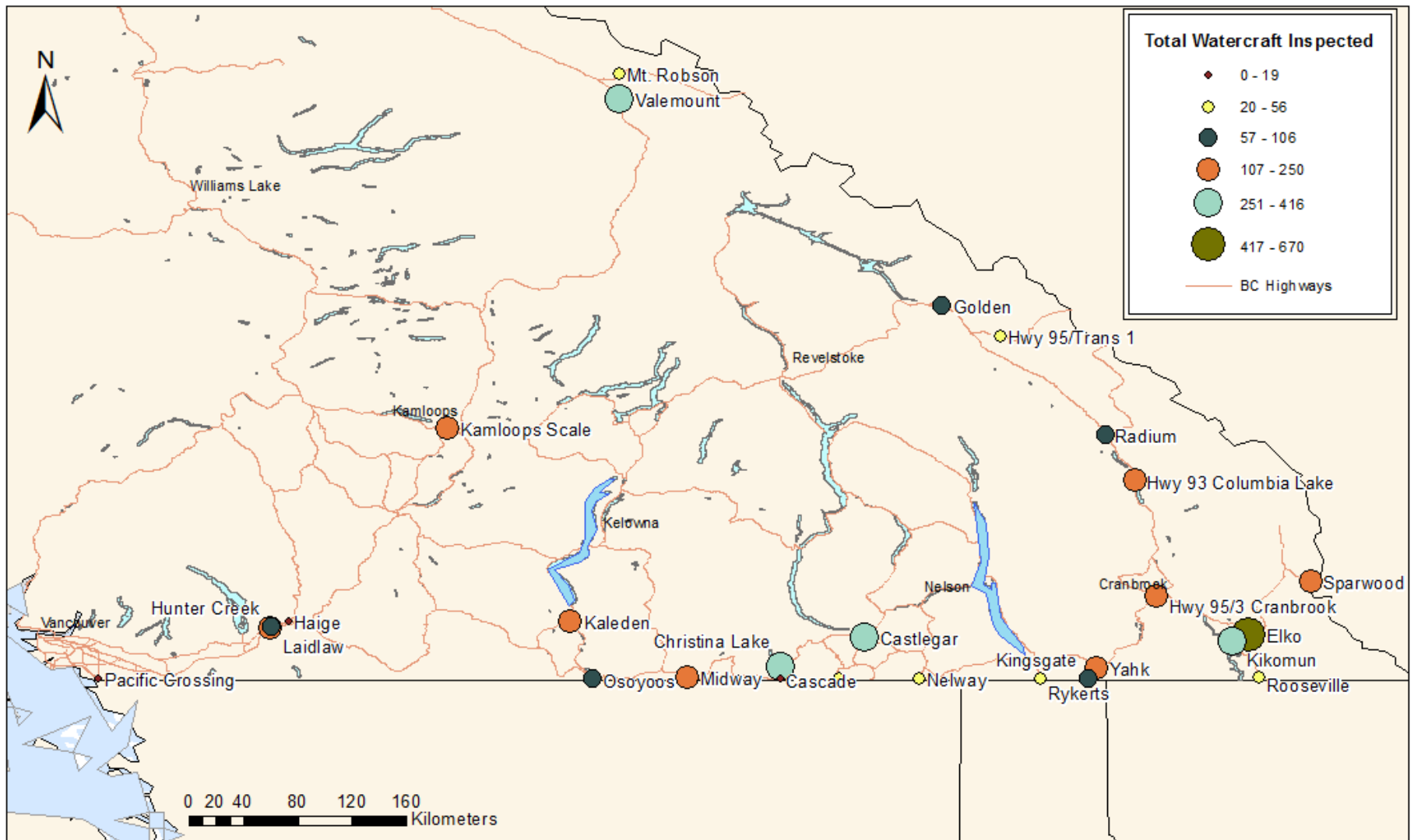
