Key Learnings from Survey

- Only a few actions are no longer relevant
- But, all actions need to be reworded and contextualized
- Need new actions and/or info around WSA (and other legislation), climate change adaptation, mussels, ecosystem services, EFN
- Participants provided a great deal of useful information in their open-ended responses

- Philosophies/beliefs/values about water that provide a framework for the strategy
- Simple statements with a short description concise and targeted
