



## DC Daily Average vs. Current Day PENTICTON RS








# **Philpott Road**

- Status: 465 hectares (estimated), 70% contained
- Resources: 82 firefighters as well as 1 helicopter are assigned to the fire today. Ground crews are being supported by 6 pieces of heavy equipment. There are also structural protection personnel assigned to this incident. The Joe Rich Fire Department is managing the fire within their response area including the Philpott Road.



## **Diamond Creek**

- Status: 5,500 hectares (estimated) Canadian portion 43,500 ha total, 0% containment, Out of control
- Resources: 2 firefighters, 4 support personnel, 1 rotary-wing aircraft, 0 fixedwing aircraft and 9 heavy equipment





# Finlay Creek

- Status: 1250 hectares (estimated), 0% containment, out of control
- Resources: 79 personnel on this fire including 47 firefighters, a Structural Protection Specialist and an Incident Management Team. Crews are supported by 10 helicopters, 23 pieces of heavy equipment and airtankers.
