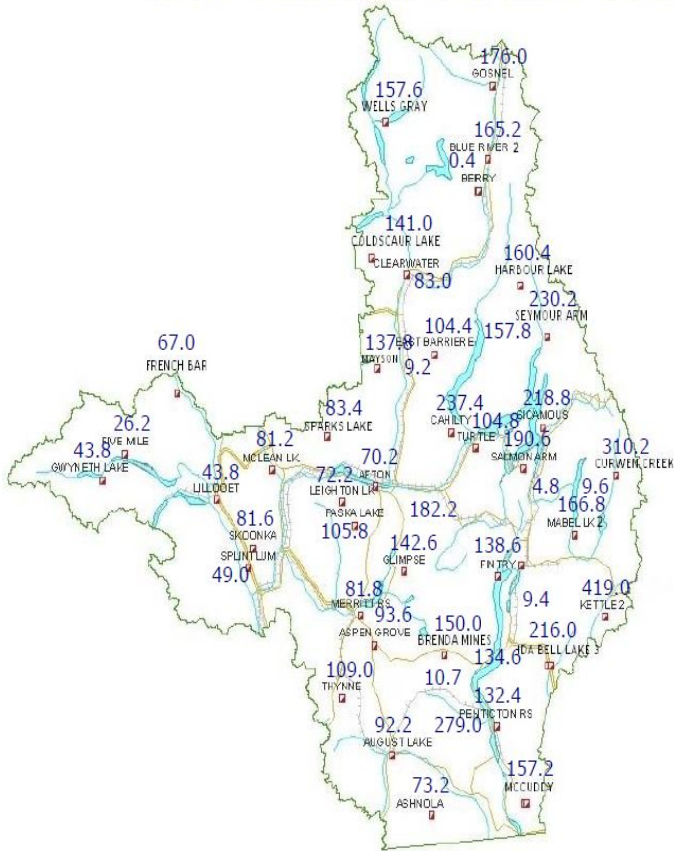

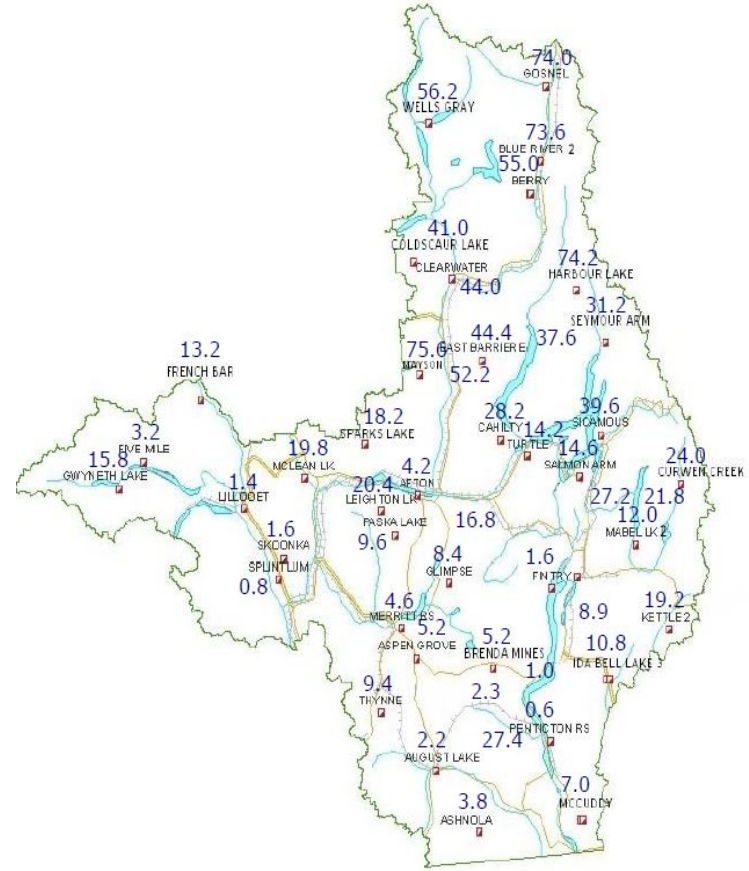

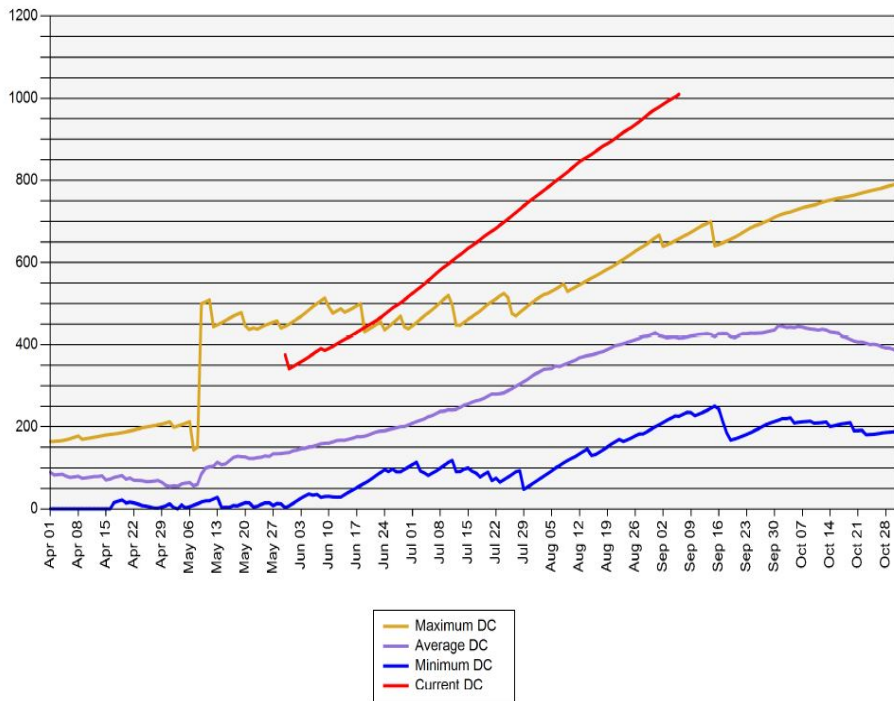
Kamloops - Precipitation for Apr 01, 2017 13:00 PST to Jun 15, 2017 15:00 PST



Kamloops - Precipitation for Jun 15, 2017 13:00 PST to Sep 06, 2017 16:00 PST

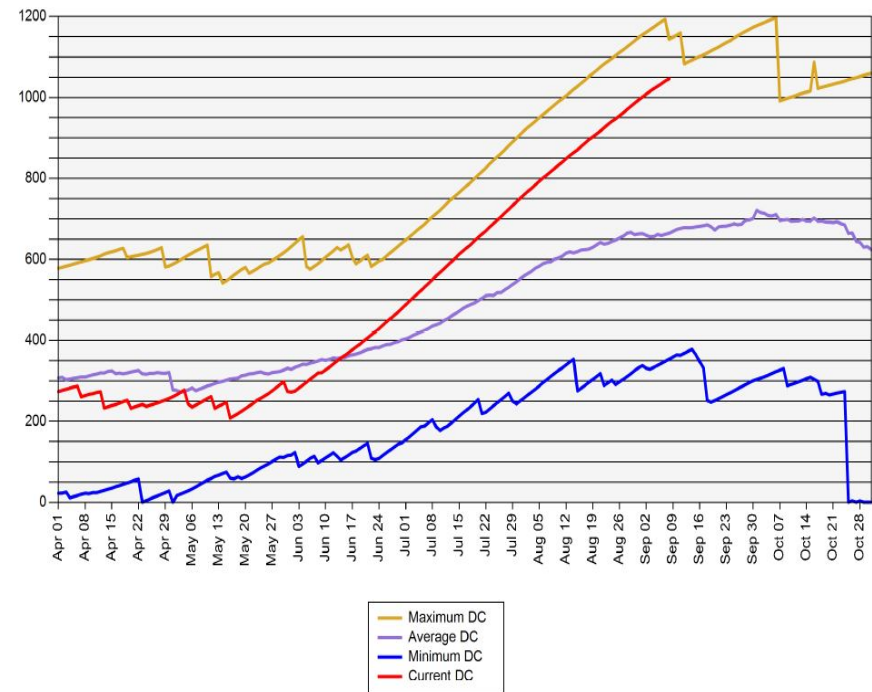


DC Daily Average vs. Current Day

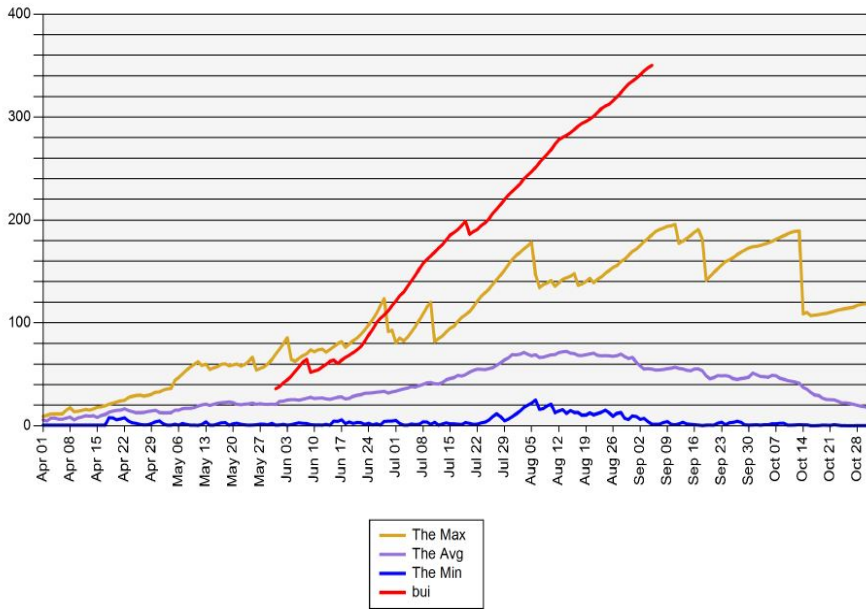
DC Daily Average vs. Current Day

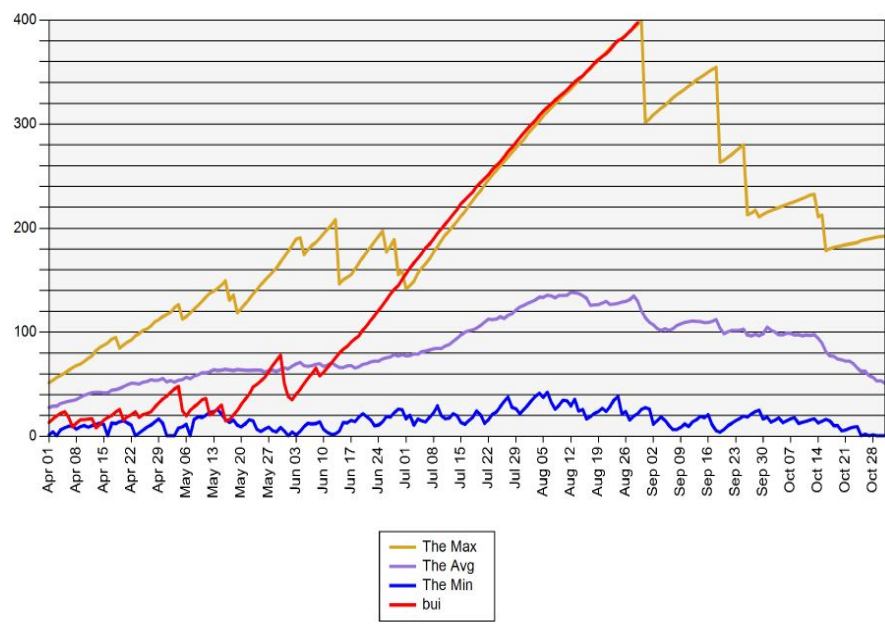

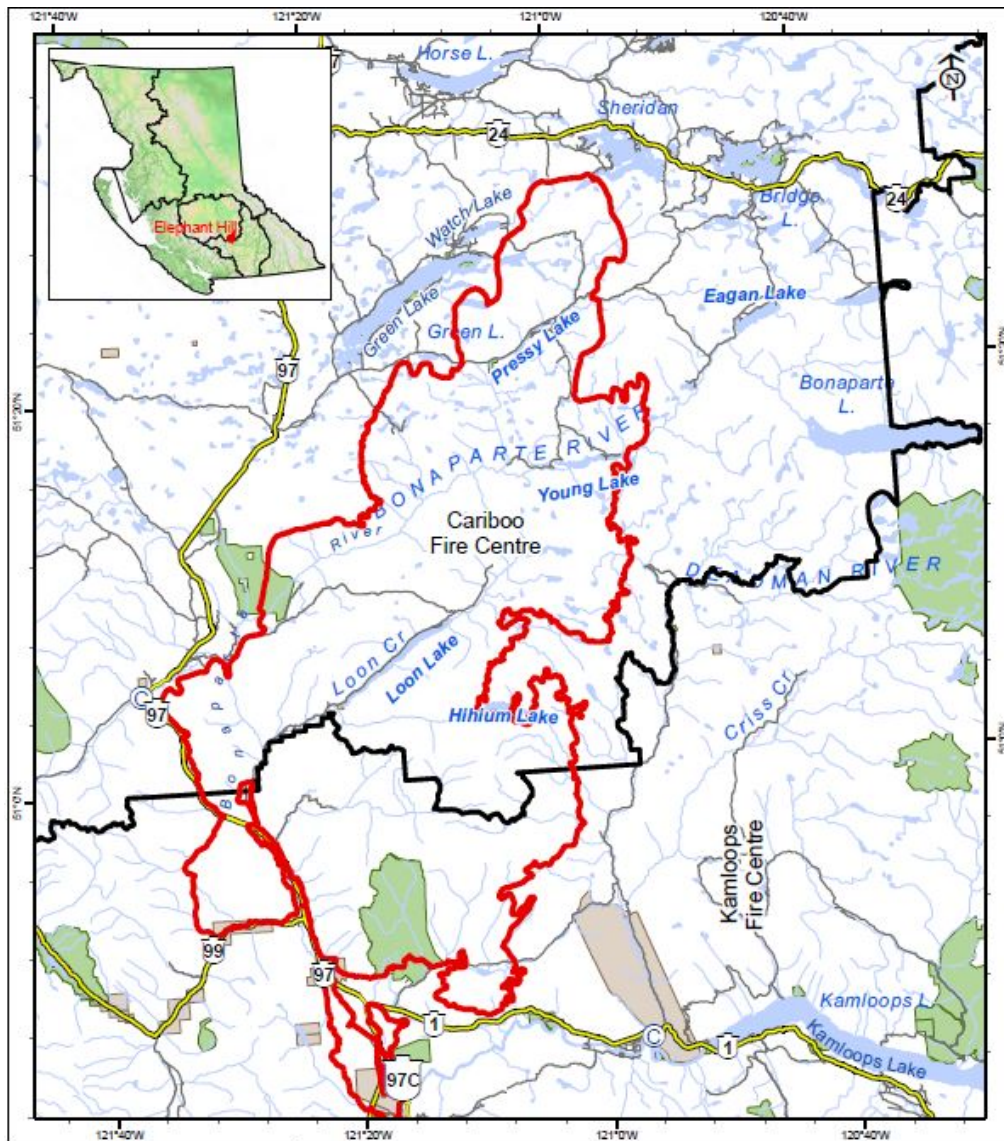

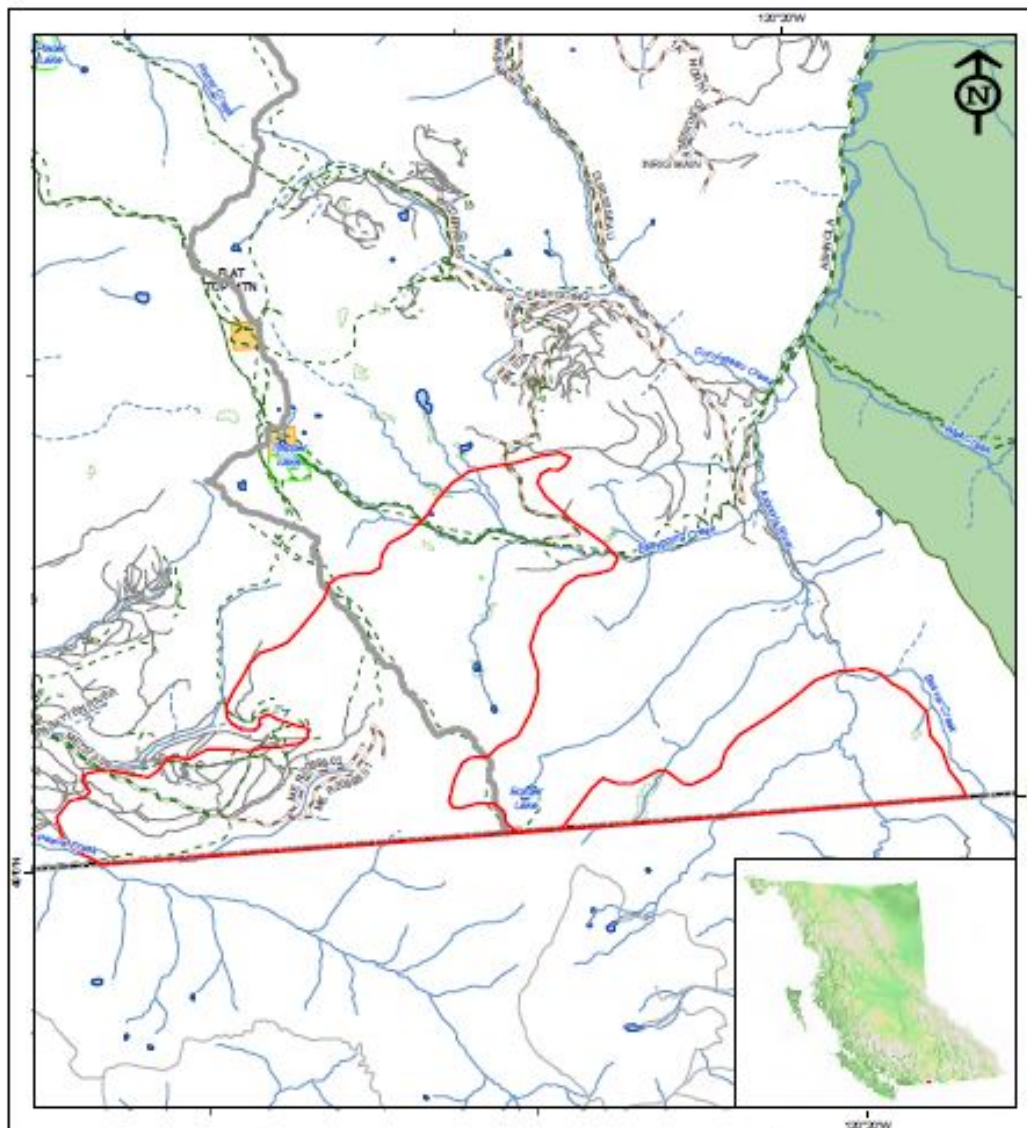


Elephant Hill August 30




- Status: 465 hectares (estimated), 70% contained
- Resources: 82 firefighters as well as 1 helicopter are assigned to the fire today. Ground crews are being supported by 6 pieces of heavy equipment. There are also structural protection personnel assigned to this incident. The Joe Rich Fire Department is managing the fire within their response area – including the Philpott Road.

- Status: 5,500 hectares (estimated) – Canadian portion 43,500 ha total, 0% containment, Out of control
- Resources: 2 firefighters, 4 support personnel, 1 rotary-wing aircraft, 0 fixed-wing aircraft and 9 heavy equipment



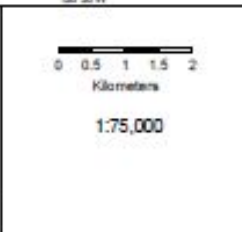

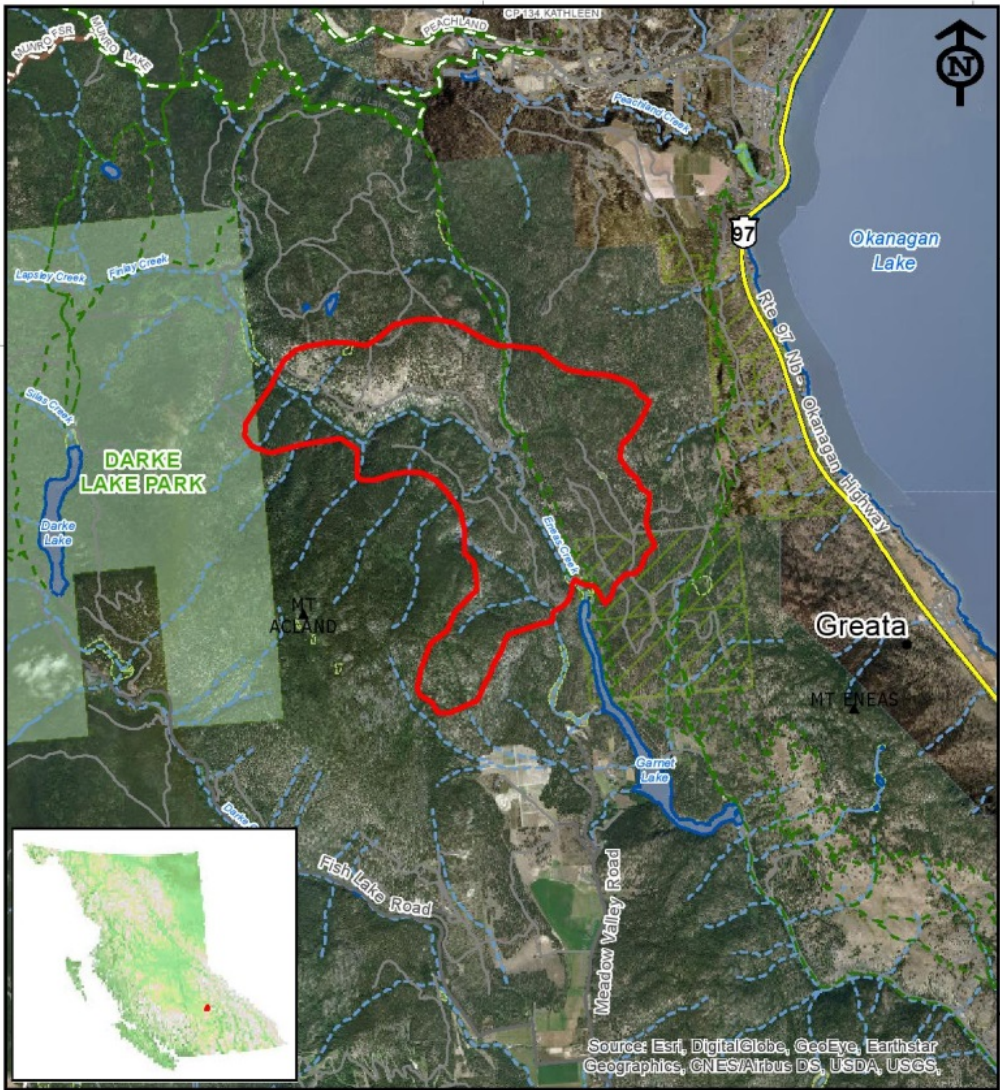

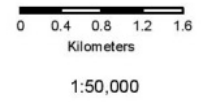
