Council Meeting Highlights^{*}

- 2017 report on Make Water Work and Don't Move a Mussel is released
- Presentation by Jason Schleppe "The status of Okanagan Biophysical Mapping" explained mapping protocol and examples of their application. Datasets include wetlands, some streams and lakes, SARA and cumulative effects but many datasets are out of date.
- Nicole Pyett "Groundwater Mapping" talked about the history, current state and future projects in GW mapping. Currently the main focus is on accommodating new regulatory requirements on GW licensing and EFNs. Future projects include establishment of robust integrated information system to support effective decision making.
- Scott Smith "OK Basin Soil Data Status, availability and gaps" coverage and resolution are mostly adequate but data is old. Most mapping was done in the past by joined effort by provincial and federal government. Nowadays many experts reside in private sector and mapping is mostly project-base and not reflecting province-wide soil conditions.
- Ted van der Gulik "Weather Station Network for Agriculture" described several platform that support agricultural decision-making. He also explained major sources of error, failures that are in some cases related to failure to communicate the changes in inputs. Climate data needs to be available to all farming communities through different kind of media.
- Craig Nicol "Natural resource mapping & data soil mapping and bedrock geology" several agencies, federal and provincial responsible for resource mapping for various purposes, including mineral extraction, science-support or project—based activities. Major challenge is that geological mapping is unconsolidated.
- SWS writing began following wrapping up the results of working session
- BC Groundwater Association AGM is April 4-5, 2018 in Langley
- WSA 2018 Annual Spring Workshop will be April 12-13 in Kelowna
- The Growing Forward 2 program is ending and a new program, Canadian Agricultural Partnership, has been announced
- RDOS have RFP out for wetlands project
- CWRA Annual National conference is the last week of May 2018 and will be held in Victoria; over 20 abstracts received for the Okanagan session.
- OBWB approved the membership invite list for the Council's eighth term.
