Water

There is less fresh water available per person in the Okanagan Basin than anywhere else in Canada.

That is the results of a 3-year study by the Okanagan Basin Water Board and Ministry of the Environment.

The study also finds we use more than two times as much water as the average Canadian, but we live in a very dry place.

Water shortages have already occurred in some areas of the basin and are expected to occur more widely and frequently in the future.
