Guest speaker Doctor Ron Griffin of Texas A&M University is surprised flat rate pricing for water in the Okanagan still exists.

"I'm concerned about the policies and the fact that you have a lot of flat rate pricing going on where people's water use is un-metered and they are just paying by the household or paying by the acre instead of paying volumetrically".

Griffin says with strong development and population growth, water metering for the Okanagan isn't an option, but a must.
