Milfoil outbreak on Osoyoos Lake worst in 20 years

Experts are calling an outbreak of Milfoil in Osoyoos Lake the worst they've seen for 20 years. Okanagan Basin Water Board representative Genevieve Dunbar says crews are working hard to harvest the invasive aquatic plant, and clear it out of the lake. Dunbar says the great thing with the harvest program is it can cover a decent amount of area in a reasonable amount of time, so crews are doing their best to stay active with the harvest. She says for the next few weeks, there will be crews working seven days a week on the program. The O-B-W-B uses a machine much like a lawnmower to cut the plant down to the root.
