## Water supply top of mind

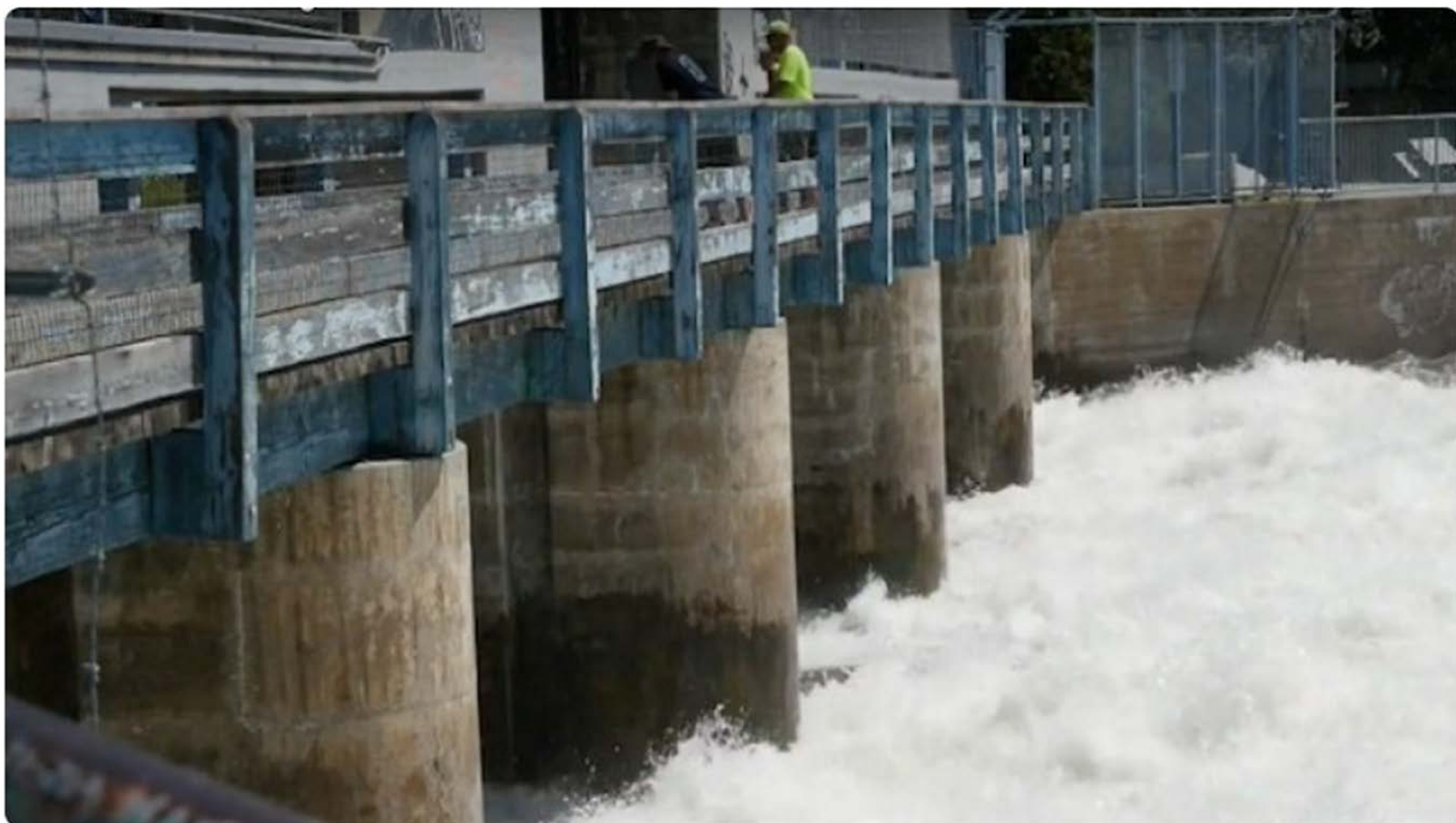

As the region prepares for the spring freshet and the possibility for flooding, the Okanagan Basin Water Board is helping locals to get a grip on this year's water supply.

The group is holding a free webinar on Monday at 11 a.m., which will "look at our current and forecasted water supply for 2018."

Topics will include precipitation and weather, water flow, groundwater levels and Osoyoos Lake levels — which are tracked internationally. Wildfire preparedness will also be discussed.

Updates from provincial and federal agencies will be included in the webinar.
