

Provincial Approach to EFN

"in relation to a stream, means the volume and timing of water flow required for the proper functioning of the aquatic ecosystem of the stream"



WSA Section 15 "Must consider"

 Decision makers are expressly required to consider EFN

- Discretionary for licensing existing groundwater use
- Discretion of decision-maker to request any information relevant to EFN

Other Legislative Protections for Aquatic Ecosystems

- Temporary protection orders (during shortages)
 - Critical Environmental Flows
 - Fish Protection Orders
 - Essential household needs protected
- Licence Terms and Conditions
- Water reservations for conservation purpose
